This year Maharana Mewar Foundation is proud to present this award to four personalities from various walks of life; these are- Dr. Nand Lal'Tiwari (Jaipur), Mr. Peeru Bhai Panwar (Udaipur), Padma Bhushan Dr. K.H. Sancheti (Pune) and Mr. Mohan Lal Shrimali (Balicha, Distt.-Rajasamand).



Dr. Nand Lal Tiwari was born in January 1940 at Nimari in Nagaur district. He is an ayurveda doctor who has made his reputation as a cancer specialist. During his service in the tea gardens in Assam he made an extensive study of various herbs, flora and fauna for curative purposes. After 20 years of research he has developed an ayurvedic formula of herbs which has successfully cured large numbers of patients suffering from the

advanced stages of cancer.

Dr. Tiwari's reputation as a man of integrity has been recognized by several international hospitals and institutions, including the TATA Memorial Cancer Hospital in Mumbai. Allopathic doctors now often refer patients to Dr. Tiwari when conventional treatment has failed to arrest the cancer.

Dr. Tiwari offers free treatment to those who cannot afford to pay. With the instances of cancer on the increase he is providing both help and comfort to those suffering from this disease.
